# **COURSE**

#### **COURSE INFORMATION**

- Exchange students are welcome to take courses offered by any departments with prior permission from the course instructors and with the completion of the required procedures.
- Exchange students are requested to select at least 1 course opened by the host department.
- Global Culture Program
  - Exchange students shall take at least 1 course under this program.
  - The program provides students with a set of balanced curricula that include both international cultures and languages.
- Credit Load
  - Minimum: 4-8 credits/ semester
  - Maximum: 27 credits/ semester
  - Average: 16-20 credits/ semester (8 to 10 courses)
- Lectures and examinations are typically conducted in Chinese. If you do not have sufficient knowledge of Chinese, you should consult the professor or instructor before enrolling in a certain course.

#### LANGUAGE COURSE

- Semester Program
  - Non-Chinese-speaking students are eligible to take "semester program" (group class) for up to 6 hours/week at Mandarin Teaching Center (MTC) without tuition.
  - For students who would like to take courses other than "semester program" or more than 6 hours/week, a 20% discount of standard tuition will be offered.
- Course Features
  - Taught by experienced instructors.
  - Small class of 20 students, meet twice/ week.
  - Class levels range from beginner to intermediate.
  - Online placement test.



### **OTHER INFO**

#### **ACCOMMODATION**

- On-campus Dormitory
  - NTNU Campus Inn is one of the newest dormitories, located at Library Campus
  - Students will receive application information for NTNU Campus Inn after being admitted as exchange students.
  - The Campus Inn will make the arrangement according to students' registration order.
- Types & Fees
  - Fee: NTD 30,000 NTD 60,000 (approx. US\$1,000-2,000)/semester (varies by the room types)
  - Room Types: 2-bed/ 3-bed/ 4-bed room (\*subject to change)

#### **VISA**

- Students from Mainland China
  - Entry Permit (applied by the host institution)
- Students from Hong Kong & Macau
  - Entry Permit (applied by students)
- Other students
  - Resident Visa- 1 academic year
  - Visitor Visa- 1 semester



#### **HEALTH EXAMINATION**

• To meet the government's requirements, all incoming new students must take a health exam by a qualified doctor and complete each examination listed on the NTNU Health Certificate for Short-Term Students (Form C).

#### **INSURANCE**

- Students must purchase their own insurance in their home country before traveling to Taiwan. They need to provide their insurance plan which valid for the entire exchange period for the following:
  - Accident Insurance worth a minimum of NTD 1,000,000.
  - Medical Insurance worth a minimum of NTD 1,000,000.
